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Who is "GOD"

according to the teachings of Jesus(pbuh*)?

Certainly they disbelieve who say: "Allah is Christ the son of Mary". But said Christ, "O Children of Israel! worship Allah, my Lord and your lord". Whoever joins other gods with Allah, Allah will forbid him the Garden, and the fire will be his abode. There will, for the wrong-doers, be no one to help. (Quran 5:72)

They disbelieve who say: Allah is one of three (in a Trinity:) for there is no god except one God. If they desist not from their word (of blasphemy), verily a grievous chastisement will befall the disbelievers among them. (Quran 5:73)

Why turn they not to Allah and seek his forgiveness? For Allah is Oft-Forgiving, Most Merciful. (Quran 5:74)

A. Jesus (pbuh) himself used to invite people towards "GOD" (Allah/Lord/Yehova).

1. Jesus(pbuh) replied, "The most important one is this: Listen, Israel! The Lord our God is the only Lord. (Mark 12:29)
2. Jesus(pbuh) answered "The scripture says, 'worship the Lord your God and serve only him!' (Luke 4:8)
3. No one can be a slave of two masters; he will hate one and love the other; he will be loyal to one and despise the other. (Mathew 6:24)
4. Do not hold on to me. Jesus(pbuh) told her, because I have not yet gone back up to the Father. But go to my brothers and tell them that I am returning to him who is my Father and their Father, my God and their God. (John 20:17)

Jesus(phub) not only said "God is one" but he also prayed to God and Practiced what he Preached.

*pbuh : Peace be upon him

B. Jesus (pbuh) worshipped only Yehova (Allah)

1. After all the people had been baptized, Jesus also was baptized. While he was praying heaven was opened. (Luke 3:21)
2. At that time Jesus (pbuh) went up a hill to pray and spent the whole night there praying to God. (Luke 6:12)

C. Jesus (pbuh) prayed to Yehova (Allah) while performing miracles.

1. Jesus (pbuh) wept and prayed to GOD for Lazarus. (John 11:35-41)

D. Jesus (pbuh) prayed to Yehova (Allah) during times of hardship.

1. He went a little further on, threw himself on the ground, and prayed that if possible, he might not have to go through that time of suffering. (Mark 14:35)
2. In great anguish he prayed even more fervently; his sweat was like drops of blood falling to the ground. (Luke 22:44)
3. He went away once more and prayed, saying the same words. (Mark 14:39)

E. Jesus (pbuh) preached to his disciples to worship Yehova (Allah)

1. But when you pray, go to your room. Close the door and pray to your Father, Who is unseen. And your Father, who sees what you do in private, will reward you. (Mathew 6:6)
2. Jesus (pbuh) said to them, "When you pray, say this; Father; may your holy name be honoured; may your kingdom come. (Luke 11:2)
3. If you believe, you will receive whatever you ask for in prayer. (Mathew 21:22)

F. Jesus (pbuh) thanked and praised only Allah (Lord)

1. At that time Jesus (pbuh) was filled with joy by the Holy Spirit and said, "Father, Lord of heaven and earth! I thank you because you have shown to the unlearned

what you have hidden from the wise and learned. Yes, Father, this was how you wanted it to happen. (Luke 10:21)

2. They took the stone away. Jesus (pbuh) looked up and said, "I thank you, Father that you listen to me. (John 11:41)

3. Then took the seven loaves and the fish, gave thanks to God, broke them, and gave them to the disciples; and the disciples gave them to the people. (Mathew 15:36)

G. People praised GOD (Allah) for the miracles performed by Jesus (pbuh)

1. The people were amazed as they saw the dumb speaking, the crippled made whole, the lame walking, and the blind seeing; and they praised the God of Israel.

(Mathew 15:31)

2. While they all watched, the man got up, picked up his mat, and hurried away. They were all completely amazed and praised God, saying, "we have never seen anything like (Mark 2:12)

3. At once he was able to see, and he followed Jesus (pbuh), giving thanks to God. When the crowd saw it, they all praised God.

(Luke 18:43)

H. Jesus (pbuh) used to announce aloud "Father is great" (Allahu-Akbar)

1. I am telling you the truth; no slave is greater than his master, and no messenger is greater than the one who sent him. (John 13:16)

2. When Jesus (pbuh) had said this, a woman spoke up from the crowd and said to him "How happy is the woman who bore you and nursed you!" But Jesus (pbuh) answered, "Rather, how happy are those who hear the word of God and obey it!"

(Luke 11:12-28)

3. After John had been put in prison, Jesus (pbuh) went to Galilee and preached the Good News from God.

(Mark 1:14-15)

4. Father (Allah) is greater than I (Jesus).

(John 14:28)

5. What my Father has given me is greater than everything, and no one can snatch them away from the Father's care.

(John 10:29)

I. The result of leaving the preaching of Jesus (pbuh)

1. "Why do you call me, 'Lord, Lord,' and yet don't do what I tell you? (Luke 6:46)
2. "But anyone who hears these words of mine and does not obey them is like a foolish man who built his house on sand. (Mathew 7:26)
3. Then I will say to them, 'I never knew you. Get away from me, you wicked people!' (Mathew 7:23)

J. The teaching of Jesus (pbuh) which was misunderstood

1. The Father and I are one. (John 10:30)
2. Believe me when I say that I am in the Father and the Father is in Me. If not, believe because of the things I do. (John 14:11)

As per what Jesus (pbuh) said, Jesus (pbuh) & GOD are not one "Physically" but they are one according to thought

For instance: Let us have a look at the few references:

1. When that day comes, you will know that I am in my Father and that you are in me, just as I am in you. (John 14:20)
2. And now I am coming to you; I am no longer in the world, but they are in the world. Holy Father! Keep them safe by the power of your name, the name you gave me, so that they may be one just as you and I are one. (John 17:11)
3. I in them and you in me, so that they may be completely one, in order that the world may know that you sent me and that you love them as you love me. (John 17:23)

As per the above references if GOD, Jesus (pbuh) and disciples were one physically then, the disciples would also

be a part of GOD along with Jesus(pbuh),
Thus, they are one only according to
thoughts and not physically.

**K. It is like prostitution and curse to worship
other than Yehova (Allah) why?**

1. Your creator will be like a husband to you,
the Lord Almighty is his name.
(Isaiah 54:5)
2. The Lord (Allah/Yehova) says “I will
condemn the person who turns away
from me and puts his trust in man, in the
strength of mortal man.” (Jeremiah 17:5)
3. You have turned away from your God and
have been unfaithful to him. (Hosea 9:1)
4. You are good to us and forgiving, full of
constant love for all who pray to you.
(Psalm 86:5)
5. You have had many lovers, and now you
want to return to me. (Jeremiah 3:1)

Thus, in the light of the teaching of Jesus
(Pbuh) it was proved that GOD
(Father/Lord/Yehova/Allah) is One.

In the end, the warning of Jesus (pbuh)

1. Not every one who calls me “Lord, Lord,”
will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only
those who do what my Father in heaven
wants them to do. (Mathew 7:21)
2. Whoever joins other gods with Allah, Allah
will forbid him the Garden and the fire will
be his abode. There will, for the wrong-
doers, be no one to help. (Quran 5:72)
